What is it?

Each year SAME Foundation chooses one of its beneficiaries as a recipient of our Mandela Day initiative, where we bring together like-minded organisations to benefit the school on the day and going forward. This year we will be working at Blair Atholl Primary Farm School in Lanseria.

When is it?

We will host the event on Mandela Day, Thursday 18 July 2019.

How do we do it?

- Donors will join us on 18 July 2018, 09h30 until 15h00.
- We will have designated areas for you to work on.
- Our team will already have done preparation work.
- We will organise all the equipment and supplies needed, as well as a team on site to assist.
- We encourage companies to bring branding for photo/video opportunities.
- We will have a professional photographer and videographer on site.
- Catering / light lunch will be provided by food trucks.
- A quick program takes place in the morning, followed by a fun day of making change.
- We have over 1000 children at the school, we will be hosting a fun day for them while we work. We have arranged sports and fun activities for the children.
- We issue you with an 18A Donation Receipt and BEE letter of thanks for your donation.

Why is this beneficial?

Our Mandela Day initiatives are always part of our larger high-impact projects. At Blair Atholl Primary School we have installed storm-water drainage systems and done extensive paving around the school. This year, with your help, we will be painting the outside of the school. With enough participants we can paint an entire school in just one day!

This Mandela Day we will also host a fun day for the children – we are extremely excited to be able to share this significant day with the children, while putting smiles on their faces. The children will take part in egg races, netball and soccer matches, face painting and other fun activities.
